Timing of Admission

All Reception year group children will start in the September following their fourth birthday.

Admissions Policy

There is no guarantee of a place for children living in the priority admission area. In the event of oversubscription, places will be allocated using the following criteria in the order given:

1. Looked After Children and previously looked after children (as defined on page 12 of the Primary Education in Essex 2018/2019 booklet);
2. Children with a sibling attending the school;
3. Children living in the priority admission area;
4. Children residing on the old USAAF base;
5. Remaining applications.

In the event of oversubscription within any of the above criteria, priority will be determined by straight line distance from home to school, with those living closest being given the highest priority.

Exceptional medical circumstances (supported by medical evidence) may override the above.
